

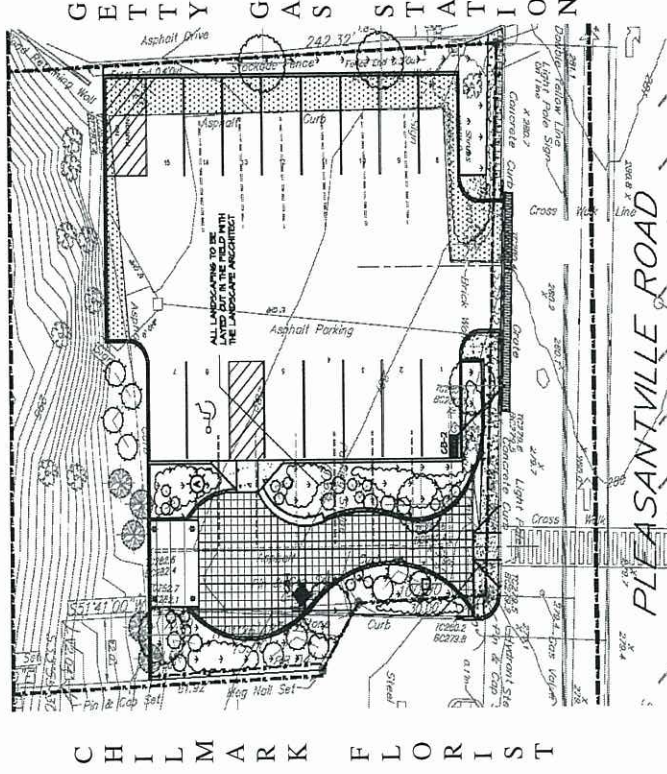

VILLAGE MANAGER REPORT

Work has commenced on the “Pocket Park” which will be located between the Municipal Parking lot and Chilmark Florist on Pleasantville Rd. The Pocket Park will include the new Village Clock, benches and tables, a pergola and landscaping which will provide some “green space” to our Central Business District. The project is a collaborative effort between the Village and the Garden Club. The project could not have proceeded without the cooperation and agreement of Chilmark Florist to exchange some property with the Village. The Pocket Park is being funded by a grant from NYS, Village funds and private donations. The Garden Club used private donations to purchase the Village Clock which will be gifted to the Village. The Municipal Parking Lot will NOT lose any parking spaces. The parking modifications will be finished by mid December and the entire project by early 2009. We anticipate that residents will enjoy these new additions to our Village.

FALL LEAF PICKUP

Leaf collection began on Tuesday, October 20, 2008. The final lap of leaf collection will begin on Monday, December 1, 2008. After that date, all leaves not at the curb when our crews pass, must be placed in paper bags for pickup on recycle Wednesday. Please do not pile leaves on the street pavement as this may cause a hazardous condition.

All leaf piles must be free of sticks and branches. -Sticks and branches must be tied or placed in brown paper bags for pickup.

The ongoing Metro-North Construction at the Scarborough Train Station has had a large impact on the parking at the station. The Board of Trustees anticipated this and based on the recommendations of an independent residents' committee, instituted the "valet parking" prior to the start of construction. The first year's cost of \$108,000 to run the valet service was funded by the Village. The valet parking has been positively utilized and has proved to be a good solution. However it was decided that the future costs of this service to train commuters, starting with 2009, should not be subsidized by all residents of the Village. Rather, it should be included in the Station Parking Permit Fee. The \$550 Permit Fee for the year has been increased by \$200 from the previous year. It should be noted that the \$550 fee is comparable to fees charged by our neighbors and in many cases is lower. On an annual basis (work days only), the fee equates to a cost of \$2.43 per day which is significantly lower than private lots.
